

Remote Learning 2.0

Dear Senior School Parents,

Welcome back to the world of remote learning! The following outlines how remote learning will continue this term:

Students are expected to be set up by 9.15am each day and will spend the first 15 minutes familiarising themselves with the day's tasks, reading and applying feedback from teachers as well as checking class communication pages.

There will now only be one daily WebEx meeting which will begin promptly at 9.30am and will run for approximately 45mins. The expectation is that all students will attend this session each day. This will provide an opportunity for teachers to explain the learning for the day, answer questions students may have and explicitly teach content when required, as well as provide feedback on previous tasks.

Each day students will need to access the Content Library of their class OneNote. In the 'Remote Learning' section they will find a weekly timetable and the daily activities. Each task will have instructions and activities for the students to work through. Students are required to complete all tasks in their personal OneNote in their 'Remote Learning' section.

Specialist classes will again be available through Compass as a 'Learning Task' and any questions relating to these tasks should be directed to the Specialist teachers during their WebEx session. Access to these classes will be via the links in the timetable. Specialist classes will continue to be timetabled in as one session per day, four days a week. (*refer to the timetable*)

Classroom teachers will be regularly checking the students' OneNote sections to provide **feedback**. It will state on the timetable which area of learning will be specifically targeted for feedback each week.

Students will continue to use class communication spaces and their own personal question and **feedback** areas to ask questions and check in with their teachers.

Please encourage your child to familiarise you with the OneNote sections and how to navigate the work that is taking place. Your child will be able to share with you the feedback we have provided about their learning.

We will also be checking emails regularly during normal work hours and will endeavour to respond as quickly as possible.

We appreciate all of your continued support, remember you are not expected to become your child's teacher, we are working together through these unknown times. Most

importantly, look after yourselves and your families and stay safe and healthy.
